The Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting June 07,2006 at 6:00 pm.  
The meeting was called to order with the pledge to the flag and roll call. Present were Trustee Pat Mahaffey Dennis Nicodemus Barbara Strussion Fiscal Officer Nancy Schroyer, Administrator Robert Stapleton.

Barbara Strussion moved to approve the minutes from May 04,2006. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Chief Sharps released the 2005 statistics. EMS runs 4182& fire runs 1157 total 5,339.

Chief sharps reported a \$250.00 gift from the VFW for participating in the community Children safety program held at the VFW on Waggoner Road.

Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to approve FF Tim Perry and FF Jeff Sharps to take classes at the University of Cincinnati, for Fire Safety course. As authorized by union contract.

Part of the intercom system has been installed in the bay area at 6900 East Main for MECC.

Pat Mahaffey moved to sell the fire truck to College Township in Knox County for \$5,000.00. Barbara Strussion seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Superintendent Larry Kaufman reported that the tree next to the pump house at the cemetery has been removed by A&M tree service for \$350.00. Franklin county vac truck had to be called out to the Qualstan area to clean out drains because the residents put trash in the storm drains.  
Estimate to repair well at cemetery was \$3,350,00 from professional water well systems.

Pat Mahaffey made a motion that the township will not reimburse sales tax on purchases.  
Barbara Strussion seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Trustee Barbara Strussion wanted to thank VFW #9473 for their services and presence at Memorial Day services.

Trustee Pat Mahaffey wanted to remind Truro Township Employees that we always cooperate with citizen's wanting public information. Available during daytime business hours.
