

Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting May 03,2007 at 6:00pm.
Present were Trustee Pat Mahaffey, and Dennis Nicodemus,
Administrator Bob Stapleton, and the fiscal officer Nancy Schroyer,

The meeting was called to order with the pledge to the flag and roll call.

The April 05 minutes were tabled. Pat Mahaffey moved to approve minutes from April 16. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion .All voted yes.

Chief Foltz asked to have approval to start a part time firefighter/paramedic program With a staff of up to 20 personnel. We currently have eleven names and Chief Foltz is asking the trustees to hire them.

Pat Mahaffey so moved to hire personnel. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

The pay rate for part-time employees would be \$10.00 per hour after increasing to \$11.00 per hour after six month's they will work a twelve-hour shift.

Chief Foltz asked the trustees to increase the full-time manpower of the department by three. They would come from the part time list.

Dennis Nicodemus made a motion to add three full times employees. Pat Mahaffey seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Chief Foltz gave the Trustees a letter from Reynoldsburg Police Department thanking the Township for the donation of the old medic to be used as a SWAT vehicle.

Captain Hein reported he applied for a grant for\$89,000.00 to be used for 20 sets of fire gear for new employees and air packs and equipment for filling air bottles for station #162.

Administrator Bob Stapleton reported on a quote from Chase Bank on investing our cemetery bequest fund. It was tabled until Trustee Strussion is present.

Special thanks to Capt. Hein for putting together the scheduling for the Drug free work place education program. The program saved the Township \$8,000.00 in premium.

Administrator asked the State Auditor Chuck Dersom where in our booking system would our total cash assets be listed. It should be in our bank reconciliation and our bookkeeping system also has an investment report that would list all money totals except checking.

Our bank balances do not agree with the reconciliation or investment report.

The Administrator will be on vacation from June 01, thru June 12, 2007

Pat Mahaffey moved to approve the payroll of \$193,771.75 and bills of \$376,183.39.
Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Pat Mahaffey authorized the Fiscal Officer to pay the payroll and bills for May
Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.
