

The Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting November 01, 2007 at 6:00 pm. Present were Trustee Pat Mahaffey, Dennis Nicodemus, Barbara Strussion Administrator Bob Stapleton and Fiscal Officer Nancy Schroyer Superintendent Stan Knoderer, Chief Foltz and Battalion Chief Steve Hein.

The meeting was called to order with roll call and pledge

Guest: Tom Schwing from American Water. Qualstan subdivision water source.

Barbara Strussion moved to approve the minutes from regular meeting October 04, and special meeting October 29.

Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Dave Little General Manager for American water and Tom Schwing Superintendent for the Blacklick area explained to the Qualstan residents, represented by Gabriel Thomas, why and how the water and sewer rates will go up if the PUCO approves their rate increase.

Chief Foltz requested that he would like to increase full time Fire Fighters buy one, Be promoted from the part time Fighter list.

Pat Mahaffey so moved. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the list. All voted yes.

Chief Foltz requested that he would like to offer, up to 10, Part Time Fire Fighter's positions with Truro Township Fire Department out of our current list of 16.

Chief Foltz reported that the new ISO ratings are in and we have advanced to a 3 rating in the Township and Brice. The city of Reynoldsburg remains at a 4.

Chief Foltz stated that Lt, Harper's retirement became official October 25, 2007. He thanked him thank him for the 30 years of service to Truro Township.

Do to all the changes in the department in the last year the current Lieutenant list will be abolished. A new promotional testing will be implemented before the end of the year.

Battalion Chief Steve Hein reported that he attended the MECC meeting October 31, 2007 and that Truro Township and Whitehall will host a stroke study program presented by Mt. Carmel East.

Superintendent Stan Knoderer reported he is working with Franklin County Board of Health on four nuisance properties in the Qualstan area. Asphalt patchwork in the Qualstan subdivision will be done in the next 30 days.

Stan reported that salt for 2007/2008 has been increased from \$44.90 to \$46.02 per ton.

Pat Mahaffey moved to name Park National Bank for our lock box account for our EMS Billing. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Trustee Dennis Nicodemus wanted to congratulate and thanks Lt.Harper on his retirement and service to Truro Township.

Pat Mahaffey moved to approve the Fiscal Officer to pay the payroll of \$202,299.75 and bills of \$332, 669, 28.Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Pat Mahaffey moved to authorize the Fiscal Officer to pay the payroll and bills for November.2007.Barbara Strussion seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Chief Foltz introduced two new fire fighters, Joe Armintrout and Brian Williams. Pat Mahaffey swore in the new fighters
