

Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting April 05,2007 at 6:00pm.  
The Present were Trustee Pat Mahaffey, Barbara Strussion, and Dennis Nicodemus.  
Administrator Bob Stapleton, the fiscal officer Nancy Schroyer,  
Superintendent Stan Knoderer

The meeting was called to order with the pledge to the flag and roll call.

Barbara Strussion moved to approve the minutes from March 01, & 12,2007  
Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Guest: Charles Bell from CJ Networks gave a talk on managing our computer system.  
After looking at our computer system he will give us an estimate on the cost to maintain it

Chief Sharps reported that Insurance Service Office, Inc. (ISO) would be here April 16<sup>th</sup> to evaluate  
Truro Township Fire Department, Franklin County, for fire insurance classification number. Our last  
survey for Reynoldsburg was in 1994.

Chief Sharps reported that from March 20 to April 04, we have had 247 runs.  
Station 161 made 142 and station 162 made 105. The average is 15.4 run per day.

Chief Foltz reported the part time physical test would be given April 15 at the fire academy. There were  
15 applicants for Part time Firefighters.

Chief Foltz had talked to Reynoldsburg Police Department about giving them our old medic 161 for  
them to use as swat vehicle.

Barbara Strussion moved to declare the medic 161 surpluses Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion.  
All voted yes.

Pat Mahaffey moved to donate the medic 161 to RPD. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All  
voted yes.

Supernatant Stan Knoderer reported he has used 7.94 tons of cold patch to fill potholes in the  
Township.

The Cemetery had been cleaned up from yuletide decorations and I have started mowing grass. I a  
getting three estimates on repairing the Mausoleum ceiling.

Two complains from residents in theQualstan subdivision about trash piling up in front yards and 5  
immobilelizes vehicles with flat tires ECT. And 2 with expired license have been reported to the  
Franklin County Sheriff.

#1---\$200,000.00 has been put back in account #10A1and the account is now in balance with the

budget.

#2--- all utilities in account 10 are wrong and the amounts are charged to the wrong account.

#3---\$2,519.56 ADP has in uncashed checks that should have been voided in October 2006. The money should be in our bank account not ADP.

#4---\$7,000.00 was put in an account 03B02 for Larry Kaufman sick time buys out.

The \$7000.00 was taken out of Account 03B01 salaries

We need to move the \$7,000.00 from 03B02 to 03B01 to reimburse salaries account.

#5---March 01 meeting we moved \$3,576.64 from the Bank of New York Trust to account 30 A 04 to clear out the bank account, so it could be spent.

My question is why the \$378,888.54 left in the Bank of New York Trust account, should be in our Bank account not theirs.
