Truro Township Trustees held a regular meeting March 01,2007 at 6:00pm.
The Present were Trustee Pat Mahaffey, Barbara Strussion, Dennis Nicodemus.
Administrator Bob Stapleton, the fiscal officer Nancy Schroyer,
Superintendent Stan Knoderer

The meeting was called to order with the pledge to the flag and roll call.

Barbara Strussion moved to approve February 2007 minutes. Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Chief Sharps reported as of the end of February Truro made 902 runs. 702 EMS runs
201 Fire runs. Average of 15.55 runs per day. Fire loss for the year is \$15,250.

Chuck Brooks is purchasing equipment for weight room at Station #162.

Chief Sharps presented information on the new couch for the EMS room at #162.

The Electrician is Installing outside lighting at 6900 East Main.

Working on hiring list. Hope to have it completed by first of April.

Asst. Chief Foltz reported that we received \$5,000.00 from the Eagles to be used to buy equipment.

Chief Foltz reported that CV Perry called and wants Truro TWP to burn the old Stapleton house at 1675 Truro road. We will burn it the last of May. Fox International from Louisiana want to film the burn. They make training films that are sold worldwide.

Road Department Stan Knoderer reported that we used 13 ton of salt so far this year

He is checking our roads twice a week for potholes and is starting a clean up program in the cemetery.

Stan would like to thank unit 2 for all their help in getting his Salter fix.

Pat Mahaffey approved December & January bank statements.

Under the recommendation of the Fiscal officer Nancy Schroyer Pat Mahaffey moved To appropriate \$3,576.64 from the investment fund on money borrowed from New York Bank to account 30 A 04.

Seconded by Dennis Nicodemus. All voted yes.

Administrator Bob Stapleton wanted to know why the Fiscal officer has not a put the \$200,000.00 in Account 10A01C that should have been done in the middle Of January. Her excuse was it wouldn't work.

And why she didn't correct the utilities account in 10 account, which she claims she new nothing about, the names are wrong and utilities are charged to the wrong account.

We have a drug free program through Workers Comp that saves us over \$8,500.00 a year on our premium. This is our first year anniversary and the requirements are that all employs must to take a two-hour class and supervisors have to take a four-hour class to keep our discount on our premium There is a cost but we get a 75% grant that takes care of most of the cost.

Trustee Barbara Strussion gave a report on our open house at firehouse #162 From 11:30AM to 2:00 pm there will be a ribbon cutting ceremony and remarks by Chief Sharps, Chief Foltz and other dignitaries.

Pat Mahaffey suggested purchasing signs for the up coming Fire levy replacement to keep our Township residents aware and informed.

Pat Mahaffey moved to approve the payroll of \$195,532.86 and bills for 165,267.15 Dennis Nicodemus seconded the motion. All votes yes.

Pat Mahaffey moved to authorize the clerk to pay the payroll and bills for March. Barbara Strussion seconded the motion. All voted yes.

Pat Mahaffey moved to adjourn the meeting.
